This is in reference to United States District Court, Western District of Louisiana, criminal case number 89-2124M-02 and your request that passport services be suspended for George Sylvester Ackerson.

Please be advised that a notice has been placed in our computer system which should enable us to notify you if Mr. Ackerson applies for another passport. The notice will remain in our system for five (5) years. In order to deny the issuance of a passport, we must be provided with a copy of the court order precluding the subject's departure from the United States.

Should the defendant be found guilty and have a sentence imposed, we request that you send a copy of the court order along with the passport surrendered by him, to the Department of State, Office of Citizenship Appeals and Legal Assistance, 1425 K Street, N.W. Room 300, Washington, D.C. 20522-1705.

Please inform this office when passport restrictions are no longer necessary, so that we can remove the notice from our computer system.
