

Criminal Background Check: Dec. 2, 2009

Background: Capt. Wilson Reyes and police officers around him indicated that they needed to apprehend Gregory James Caton because he needed to be “investigated” – as if all orders weren’t being directed by the U.S. Consulate in Guayaquil, and any notion there was a violation of Ecuadorian law was a smokescreen.

This document proves it.

Issued on December 2, 2009 by the Ecuadorian National Police, the report clearly indicates that there is NO CRIMINAL RECORD ON FILE.
